Re: EDSALL ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Dear Neighbor:

The City of Alexandria Department of Transportation and Environmental Services (T&ES) is planning to reconstruct Edsall Road, from South Whiting Street to the City's border with Fairfax County. The existing pavement, curb, gutter, and sidewalk are deteriorating and have required frequent maintenance over the past ten years. The reconstruction project involves the milling and removal of existing pavement, the laying of new pavement and in some locations replacement of the curbs, gutters and sidewalks. The project also improves pedestrian access and safety by installing Americans with Disabilities Act compliant ramps, marked pedestrian crosswalks and pedestrian signals at intersections controlled by traffic signals. The construction is tentatively scheduled to start in Summer 2012, and will last for approximately six months.

The City is holding a public information meeting at Samuel Tucker Elementary School, 435 Ferdinand Day Drive Alexandria, Virginia 22304 on March 7, 2012 from 6:30pm – 8:30pm to provide an overview of the project and answer questions.
