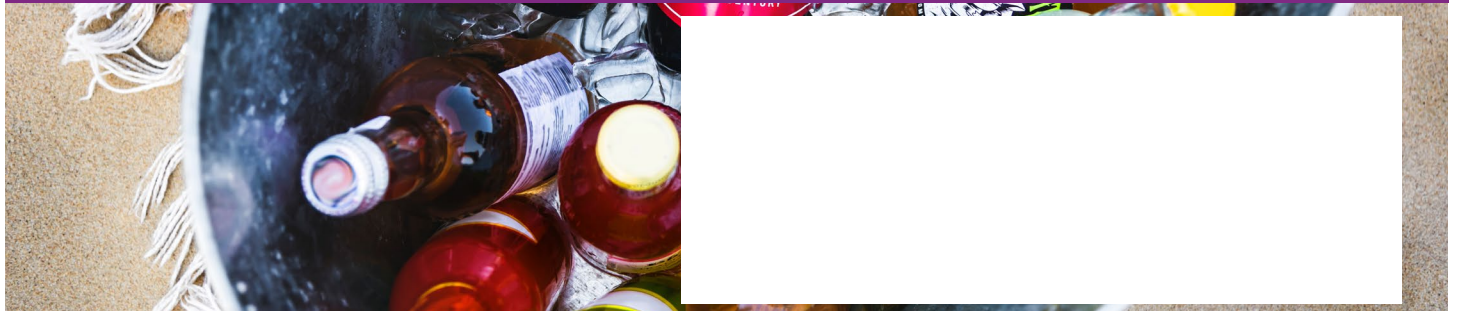

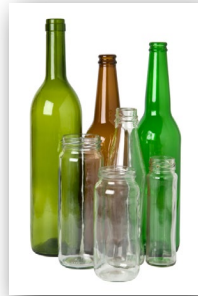

Glass Bottles & Jars

As you may have heard, the region has been facing challenges with respect to recycling glass. While it is still ok to put glass in the blue recycling bin, the City has established four drop-off centers to improve the recyclability of glass. This is the best way to ensure that your glass will be recycled.

Glass separated at these centers will be hauled to a processing plant in Fairfax County to be recycled into gravel and sand that can be used locally. These end products could be used in landscaping and construction projects.
