

LEAF COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS:

3 Ways to Recycle Your Leaves!

#1 Rake leaves to the curbside for vacuum truck collection

Proper Preparation

- Remove stones, litter, branches or other debris. These items can damage our equipment and hurt workers!
- Avoid placing leaves in front of storm drains or water meter covers. Move parked cars off of leaf piles.
- Rake leaves into piles at the curb, it enables crews to move more quickly and collect leaves more efficiently.
- Ensure leaves are visible at the curb, not in alleys or service roads.
- Avoid using plastic bags because they will not be recycled through the City's leaf collection program.

During peak leaf season, crew will focus on removing large leaf piles. Please be patient as loose leaves may be left until the next pass through your neighborhood.

Please Note:

Leaves must be raked out the day BEFORE the earliest collection day scheduled for your area. Each scheduled pickup is greatly affected by weather and rate of leaf dispersion.

2010 Leaf Collection Schedule & Service Areas

- Refer to map to identify collection area.
- Remember crews may take two or more days to finish a collection area, but they will only pass your address once during an assigned collection period.

Area I

Rake Out	Start
Oct. 30.....	Nov. 1
Nov. 16.....	Nov. 18
Dec. 7.....	Dec. 9

Area II

Rake Out	Start
Oct. 25.....	Oct. 27
Nov. 13.....	Nov. 15
Dec. 4.....	Dec. 6

Area V

Downtown crews start on October 27 on the north side of Old Town and move toward the south side. Pick up for this area is repeated throughout the collection period in this manner.

Area III

Rake Out	Start
Nov. 7.....	Nov. 9
Nov. 28.....	Dec. 30
Dec. 15.....	Dec. 17

Area IV

Rake Out	Start
Nov. 2.....	Nov. 4
Nov. 21.....	Nov. 23
Dec. 12.....	Dec. 14
