 - 2) Installation of a NO U-TURN sign at the intersection of Valley Drive and Martha Custis Drive.
 - 3) The removal of one parking space on the north side of Valley Drive and one space on the south side of Valley Drive in front of the school
 - 4) The installation of NO PARKING OR STOPPING 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. signs on the north side of Martha Custis Drive between the school parking lot entrance and the main school entrance.
